TWO SESSIONS: Wednesday, July 28, 6-8pm AND Wednesday, August 4, 6-8:30pm

You will make a reversible shoulder bag with Japanese fabric and Sashiko stitching. You'll learn the basic skill of Sashiko and how to transfer the design onto fabric. In the second class you will assemble the bag.

Make your fun in the snow while learning machine wool appliqué with a variety of felted wools on a cotton background. Felted wool is wonderful to work with and adds texture to this adorable wall hanging.

You may choose to do the appliqué with cotton fabric instead of wool if you prefer.

Finished size is 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Beginner Needleturn Hand Appliqué

Saturday, August 28, 10am - 4pm (The June class is full.)

Instructor: Karen Pessia; Class Fee: \$50.00 (includes kit) **CLASS LIMIT: 10**

This class is for those with no experience in appliqué. Karen will cover all the basics using the 'freezer paper on top' method. She will cover the basic techniques of bias stems, outside curves, circles and points along with some basic embroidery to embellish and finish off your appliquéd piece.

Needle Felted Shawl

Saturday, September 11, 11:30am - 2:30pm **CLASS LIMIT: 10**

Instructor: Lyn Slade; Class Fee: \$55.00 (includes roving and shawl)

Have some fun embellishing your own pre-fringed, 100% black wool shawl/scarf. You will use a painterly style of needle felting to add blue and deep rose flowers to each end. Participants should have some needle felting experience, either on their own or in one of our classes. Shawl measures approx. 15" x 80".

What a great project to keep for yourself or give as a gift.

Beginner Sashiko

Saturday, September 18, 10am - 4pm **CLASS LIMIT: 8**

Instructor: Miho Takeuchi; Class Fee: \$50.00 (includes kit)

Sashiko is a very old form of hand sewing using a simple running stitch, sewn in repeating or interlocking patterns through one or more layers of fabric. You will become familiar with what Sashiko is, practice Sashiko stitching and learn how to transfer Sashiko patterns onto fabric.

"Hooked Sunflower" Make-Do Pincushion

Instructor: Diane Daniels; Class Fee: \$70.00 (includes kit)

Diane has combined two different mediums (rug hooking and appliqué) in this seasonal make-do which is attached to a vintage textile spool "stem" that is mounted to bent, wire legs. This class is designed to give you a basic introduction to rug hooking while making a decorative yet functional pincushion!

NEW!!! Reversible Kinchaku Drawstring Bag

Sunday, September 26, 11am - 4pm **CLASS LIMIT: 8**

Instructor: Miho Takeuchi; Class Fee: \$35.00 (plus pattern)

This is the most traditional bag used in Japan for both personal belongings and lunches. The construction of the bag is unique, and you will stitch Sashiko (family crests in Japan) on a few of the blocks.

Students with no previous Sashiko are welcome.

NEW!!! Kofu Wall Hanging

TWO SESSIONS: Sundays, October 3 & 24, 12:30 - 3:30 **CLASS LIMIT: 8**

Instructor: Miho Takeuchi; Class Fee: \$45.00 for both sessions (plus pattern)

Inspire the Asian within you! Make this traditional Japanese wall hanging with traditional Japanese fabrics (or your own fabrics if you like). You will learn Sashiko stitching and the piecing construction for this beautiful wall hanging. Sewing machine necessary. Students with any level of Sashiko experience are welcome.
